And the Grand Jurors of the County of Osceola, duly called, impaneled and sworn to inquire and true presentment make in and for the body of the County of Osceola, upon their oaths do present that ANTHONY JOHN TODT, on or between the 1st day of December, 2019 and the 13th day of January, 2020, in said County and State, did, in violation of Florida Statute 782.04(1)(a)(1), from a premeditated design to effect the death of a female identified as MEGAN DENISE TODT, a human being, unlawfully kill a female identified as MEGAN DENISE TODT.

COUNT FIVE




